Communion for the Homebound: We invite homebound parishioners who wish to receive Holy Communion to call the office.

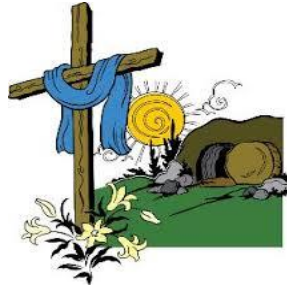
