Statement of Bishop Joseph C. Bambera, D.D.D., J.C.L.

Regarding Dallas Shootings

8 July 2016

Once again, our nation has been confronted by the sad consequences of a senseless and violent shooting that took place in Dallas, Texas last evening. In the context of a peaceful demonstration against the police shootings of two black men in Louisiana and Minnesota earlier this week, five police officers were shot and killed in what appears to have been a coordinated attack.

Our faith and history remind us that violence is never the way to confront violence. Yet, tragically, the innocent lives of these police officers were taken as they sought to protect the very rights of those who were protesting other acts of violence.

Please join me in praying for all victims of violence and for the resolve to live in peace with one another. All lives matter and all lives deserve the respect and dignity afforded to them as children of God.

As we pray for the victims of the Dallas shooting, may we also remember the countless numbers of men and women in law enforcement who stand in harm's way on a daily basis to protect our communities and keep us safe.
