July 11, 2017

Members Present: Father Jacek, Theodore Sherrill, Maureen Dillon, Helen Cebula, Bob Burns, Michael Flynn, Rosemary Coates, and Debbie Madrack. Also present was Debbie Goodman.

The meeting opened with a prayer.

Old Business

1. The Organ Capital Fund Raising was tabled due to the absence of John Kurilla.
2. The outside lighting repairs have been completed.
3. Repairs at the Chapel of St. Mary's Cemetery are ongoing.
4. The third floor siding at the rear of the rectory has not been completed.
5. Frank Meredick is still recuperating, Guy Goodman will continue to do the maintenance repairs until he returns.
6. A new copier with added capabilities was delivered. Also, the new contract will realize substantial monthly savings.
7. The Bingo was a great success realizing \$4,229.00. There were many volunteers helping to make things go smoothly.
8. The *Diocesan Directives for Parish Finance Councils* was distributed and discussed. Our Finance Council is in compliance with the directives.

New Business

1. The Boiler Room at the Holy Child Faith Formation Center is not up to the PA Code with regard to air flow standards. The flanges on the pipes need to be repaired with the estimate not to exceed \$2,000.00 also, a 12 inch circular fan needs to be installed from the room to the outside. The cost will be \$3,200.00.
2. The 2017-2018 Budget was distributed, reviewed, and approved.
3. The cumulative 2016-2017 Financial Statement was reviewed. This will be included in the bulletin on Sunday.

The next meeting date will be Tuesday, October 10th at 6 PM.
