One wisdom-filled question is being asked today: If the Lord comes today, do we have enough oil in our lamps to be ready when he arrives? If not, then changes must be made to obtain the reserve needed.

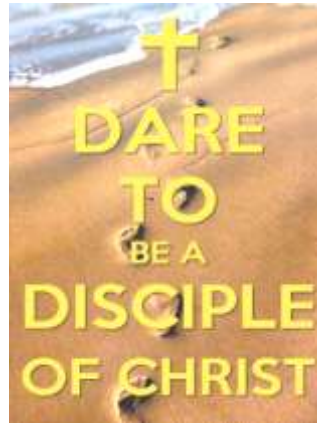
