Jesus' death and resurrection, and now his ascension, show that the new creation is about to happen. However, like the first creation, it begins with an outpouring of love for all, just as God began the first creation with the pronouncement, "Let there be light." God showcases the new creation with a new kind of light. With similar words recently heard at the Easter Vigil, God easily can chant for all to hear, "The light of Christ." Jesus is the centerpiece of the new creation. And Jesus' last instructions give an indication of what life is like in this new creation.
