Jesus' peace brings us the assurance that nothing can separate us from his love. Jesus' peace strengthens our faith and trust that we will be victorious over trials and suffering as Jesus was. Jesus' peace enables us to live with optimism and grace. Jesus tells us: "Do not let your hearts be troubled or afraid." If we choose to abide in Jesus' peace and seek opportunities to share that peace with one another, we will have no reason to be troubled or afraid. Every breath we take is a reminder of the Holy Spirit within us and the gift of Jesus' peace in our hearts. Let us breathe deeply today – and be at peace.
