Our decision to follow Jesus is never without such hankerings after the alternatives, and needs constant reaffirmation. Seldom do we choose a radical option, like Elisha's slaughter of his farmanimals before leaving home to follow Elijah. Rarely do we so fully follow the Holy Spirit as to be totally free for God's service.


