ATTENDEES MUST...

- Wear a mask at all times while on campus and during Mass
- Remain 6 feet apart (unless members of the same household)
- Wash or sanitize hands
- Follow posted signage
- Follow staff and usher instructions

DURING MASS, NO...

- Physical sign of peace
- Chalice distribution
- Communal song books
- Passing of collection baskets (ushers will collect)
- Congregating before or after Mass

DURING COMMUNION...

- Eucharistic Ministers will wear masks
- You are asked to receive Eucharist in the hand
- Attendees will remain in their area and Eucharistic Ministers will come to them

PLEASE REMAIN HOME IF...

- You are immunocompromised
- You feel sick or have problems with breathing/coughing
- You suspect you may have been exposed to COVID-19
- You are over the age of 65 or their caretaker
- You have a sick family member at home

ATTENDEES ARE ENCOURAGED TO BRING...

- Sunscreen
- Lawn chair & Umbrella
- Water
- Hand sanitizer

PARKING & SEATING
