## FROM THE PASTOR.....

Next Sunday is the feast of the Ascension of our Lord back to heaven and then the following week is the great feast of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost and then conclusion of the Easter season. So after the Apostles had seen our Lord leave them at the crucifixion but then come back to them with the resurrection, he is preparing to leave them again. But before he leaves them, he gives them two parting gifts; The Holy Spirit and his own Peace. He doesn't give them all the answers to the questions they have. He knows that they will have to face difficulties, disagreements and differences. So he prepares them for the road ahead by strengthening and encouraging them with His risen life through the gifts of the Holy Spirit and his own inner Peace. He is sending them out to proclaim the good news, but he does not expect them to do it on their own. Encouraged by His presence they will never be alone or helpless and you know what? Neither are we. We are asked face our daily reality and lives not just with optimism which can really only go so far, but with faith and hope in the risen Jesus and in each other, those of us blessed by the Spirit of God. Through celebrating and sharing in the resurrection every time we come to Mass, each of us also shares in and experiences the Peace of Christ and the power of the Holy Spirit. As we continue our journey through Easter, pray that we will be blessed with the gifts of Christ's Peace and encouraged by the power of the Holy Spirit.

## HIGH SCHOOL CONFIRMATION

The Archdiocese has changed the Confirmation program to 2 years of catechesis. If you have a child that is going into 8<sup>th</sup> or 9<sup>th</sup> grade in the Fall, they may attend the summer CCD program this June or July to complete year one of Confirmation. If they do attend this Summer session, only those in the 9th grade may register for the Confirmation class in the Fall for year 2, and be Confirmed in May, 2020.
