This past weekend at the 11:00 Mass we had a young man who obviously had just come from one of the mental health facilities that is nearby our parish. At first he did not pose a threat, but after awhile he was noticed on camera defecating in the auditorium in one of the trash cans. The UNM Police were called in and they told us that this young man had actually been banned from the campus and had a history of violent behavior. So praise God that nothing more came from this, but after looking at the cameras it was clear that several people had seen him before Mass but nothing was done. He was obviously dressed in a mental health facility jumper and entered the church a couple of times. In this day and age where we are quite frankly living in some dangerous times, though we have to be charitable to others, we can't be naive either and we can't be too careful. So here are a couple of things to take note. If there is a suspicious character in the gathering space or in the one of our bathrooms and that person is acting strange or is making one feel uncomfortable, and especially if that person is a possible threat, then please call the UNM Police. The Campus Police are some great people who have helped us out countless times. But also, there were children in the gathering space as there normally is, and this person was making comments about the children. Now could you imagine one of those children going to one of the restrooms and seeing this guy half naked doing his business in the auditorium? If there is ever again such a situation, please bring the children into the church until the Campus Police arrive. But it's up to all of us to make sure that we keep our church safe, especially during our Masses. May you all have a blessed week. Fr. Michael DePalma

HIGH SCHOOL CONFIRMATION

The Archdiocese has changed the Confirmation program to 2 years of catechesis. If you have a child that is going into 8th or 9th grade in the Fall, they may attend the summer CCD program this June or July to complete year one of Confirmation. If they do attend this Summer session, only those in the 9th grade may register for the Confirmation class in the Fall for year 2, and be Confirmed in May, 2020.
