FROM THE PASTOR.....

Do you pray enough? Here is some info based on several research studies that show the health benefits of prayer. 1. Prayer improves self-control. A German study found that prayer can help fight against mental fatigue where we just sort of drift and not get much done. Those who prayed were able to complete even challenging tasks. 2. Prayer enhances relationships. This is primarily because prayer helps us to be able to sacrifice for people and so we are less self-ish. 3. Prayer improves our ability to cope with stress. A University of Florida study showed that seniors who prayed regularly were much better able to cope with the ups and downs of life. 4. Prayer actually turns on in our bodies' disease fighting genes. Harvard Medical School discovered that prayer activates numerous genes in our body, but especially those that help keep us healthy. 5. Prayer fights off depression. Several studies show that people who pray daily have a 90% less risk of developing major depression because of how being in tune with God helps not just our souls but actually our brains. 6. Prayer helps control pain. A Bowling Green University study showed that prayer actually helped reduce the number of migraines in those people who participated in the research. 7. Prayer promotes longer life. The Journal of Gerontology polled 4,000 senior citizens and found that those who prayed on a daily basis coped better with illness and lived longer and more peacefully than those who did not. So pray constantly! Prayer not only benefits our hearts and souls, but everything about us.

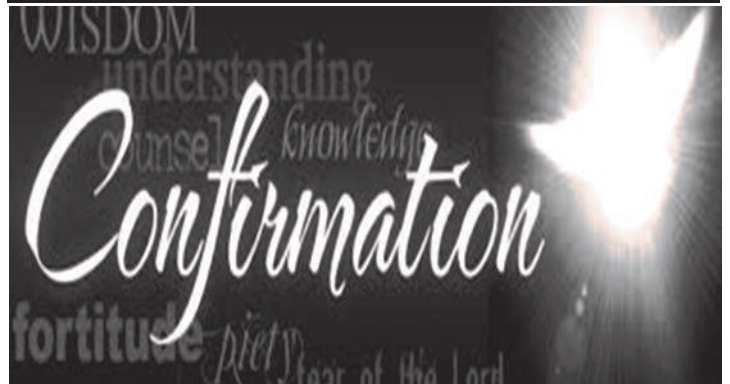
Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

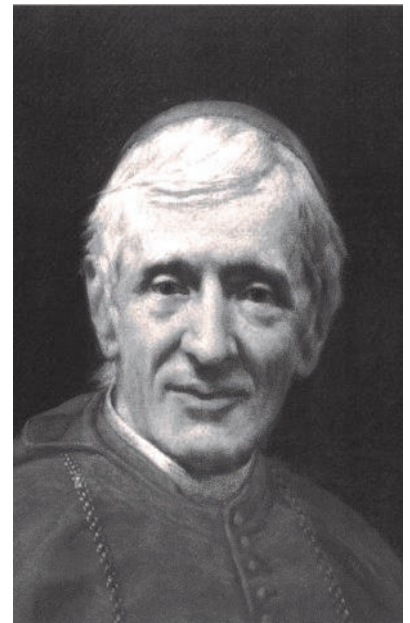
