The priest who is the editor of the publication, *Magnificat*, Fr. Sebastian White has a very precise reflection on the readings for this weekend:

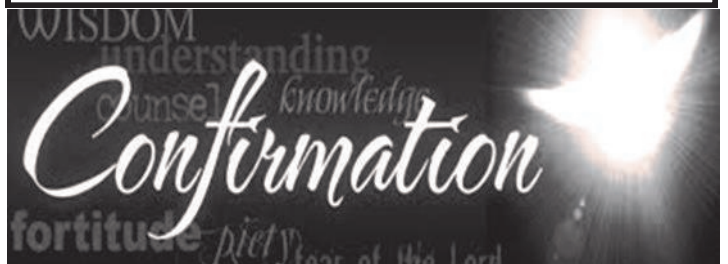
"Perhaps the most horrifying scenario imaginable is to stand outside knocking on a locked door only to hear the Lord respond, "I do not know where you are from." Through the mouth of the Prophet Isaiah, the Lord assures us: "I come to gather nations of every language." But some resist that invitation. In order to join God's gathering, we must "enter through the narrow gate." But that does mean our own personal efforts or burdensome obligations, but saying yes to the relationship Christ wants to have with us. The Letter to the Hebrews says that "God treats you as sons." When we change and conform our life to our calling to be God's children, then those who are last will be first. We will recline with them at table in the Kingdom of God."

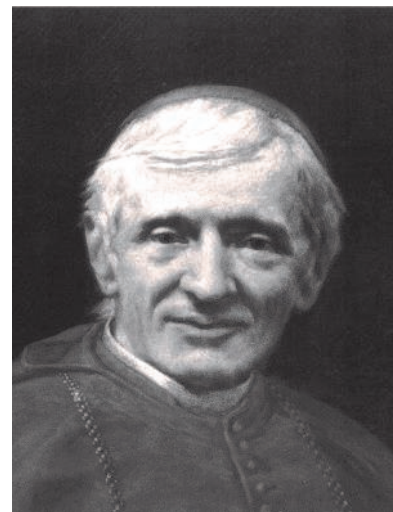
