FROM THE PASTOR.....

In our Gospel this week our Lord Jesus gives us three parables about things that are lost--the lost sheep, the lost coin and the lost son as we have this weekend the great parable of the Prodigal Son. All three parables are a response to the complaint of the Pharisees and scribes that Jesus welcomes sinners and eats with them. So we have the powerful response to a criticism but also a very clear realization of why our Lord came to us here on the earth in the first place--we're all lost at some time or another. We are all in need of being found. Love, which of course ultimately is God, is not content until the object of that Love--all of us--are back within His presence and embrace, until we are all back home. Now sometimes things get lost, like the sheep or the coin or our remote control or our minds! But sometimes we purposely get ourselves lost because of our sins or our selfishness. But that is exactly why God pursues us, not to squash us once He finds us, but to welcome us back to the arms of true and total Love. So don't get lost! Stay home within the Sacraments, within the Church, but if you find that you are lost, that you have drifted away, then don't be surprised at all to find a God, a loving God coming after you to bring you back, to the fullness of the Church, to the Sacraments, especially that of confession, and to His very heart.

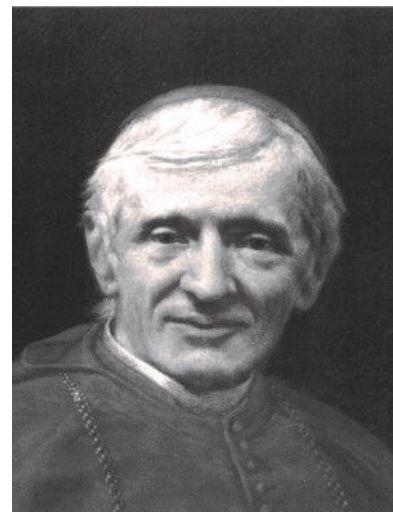
