FROM THE PASTOR.....

In our Gospel this weekend we have the statement from our Lord Jesus that "You cannot serve both God and mammon." Mammon is an interesting word. Originally "mammon" was a place, kind of like a treasure chest where you kept your valuables, but over the years it has come to be known as "money, wealth, material possessions." But mammon can also refer to the attachment that we give to anything excessive, such as gluttony, greed, or dishonest gain. Now what our Lord Jesus is telling us is that we cannot "serve" or to be more specific, become a "slave" to both God and anything else that is not God. Now for some, they may say that they might like some of the nicer things in life, but to be a slave to such things, that seems to be a bit much. But in the Biblical notion of being a slave, and remember, that is the more accurate translation of what the Blessed Virgin Mary said about herself when she answered Gabriel, "Behold I am *the slave* of the Lord, may it be done to be according to your word," this means that our entire lives, all that we do, all that we think, all that we feel, how we pray, should be centered on serving God. But there are so many things in this world that scream for our attention, or pull out desires away from God and onto things. But we must stay focused. Sure, we have to work hard and sometimes it's nice to get something for our efforts like a good, fancy meal at a restaurant, or a good, dependable car, or to make sure that our finances are safe and secure, but we cannot afford to let anything that is not of God consume us. We have to be faithful servants, faithful slaves, serving with our entire lives our Lord and our Savior. But since Jesus is such a loving God, does he keep us at the level of being slaves? No! Let Jesus tell you, let him encourage you because of your faithfulness to hear those words of his from John 15: 15 *"No longer do I call you slaves, for the slave does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you."*
