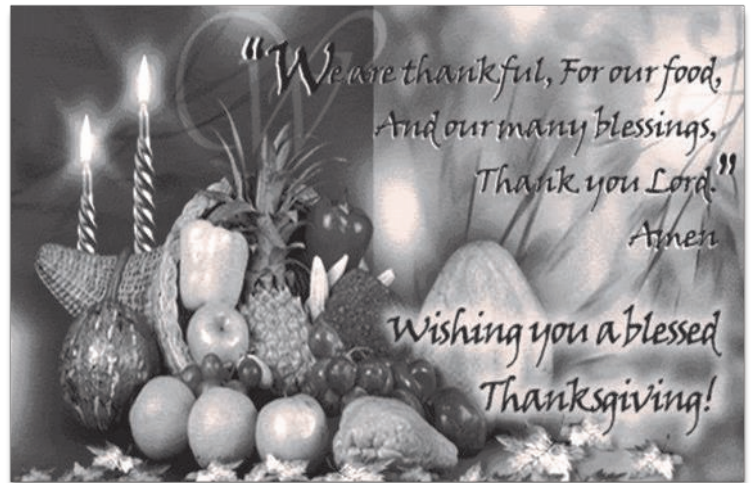
**FROM THE PASTOR.....**

With our liturgical year coming to an end with only two more weeks of ordinary time before the season of Advent, our readings have to do with the end times, and with strong references to Judgment Day. But if the last judgment is to have real meaning in our lives, we cannot just think about others being judged, rather, we should focus on the fact that we ourselves will be judged: that the Lord will determine if we are to be numbered with the sheep or the goats. Yes, we are sinners and we have failed many times in trying to live out a true Christian life. We are lying to ourselves if try to hide from this fact.

That we will be judged is sobering, yes, but we should not be living in fear or despair. The fires of Hell are real, but God's love and mercy also exist, and they are more powerful than our sins. When all of us were created, we were intended for God. We may be bruised and ruffled up because of sin and leading a mediocre life, but God wants us "to be like the stars, forever." No matter what we have done, God will forgive us, if we have the courage to ask for His forgiveness. He is calling to each of us, offering us the grace we need to kneel before him and confess, as the Prodigal Son did, that "I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son [or daughter]". And he is waiting to lift us up, embrace us and cry out, "let us rejoice and celebrate, for this child of mine was dead, but is alive again!"

The Eucharist which we receive this weekend is a foretaste of this feast, for that is what Judgment Day is really supposed to be for those who have lived their lives in Christ, a great feast day. But the Eucharist is also the source of the grace we need to turn again to the Father; it is the source of the strength we need to journey through this life and to enter into the life of the world to come, where all things are made new.

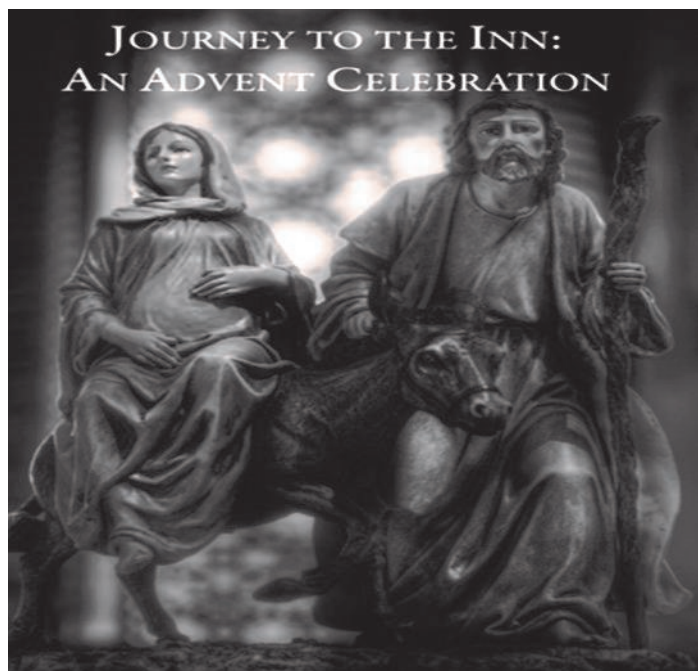
