A MESSAGE FROM FR. DEPALMA

Every one of us has an obligation to God and to every other one to be the best person we can be. And our Lord will give us every good gift from the Holy Spirit in order for us to become our best. The Christian Community, the Church, is our way to God. We are the Body of Christ. We are therefore accountable to each other for our actions. Some people think that their actions have no effect upon others. They think that what they may do privately, stays private. But when a person sins, even in a so called hidden way, that loss of the presence of Christ, which happens every time we seriously sin, effects the family, and since we are all connected, the entire Church community. Now I'm not just preaching to you all, I have to take this message seriously to myself. As a priest, I am accountable to you to strive to be the best Catholic, Christian and priest I can be. This is not some nice idea. This is actually a great responsibility, one given to us at our ordination. You deserve that I be accountable to you. So I can't just be all free and loose with morality or the truth and then look you all in the eye while preaching or giving advice in the confessional. I have to live the good, Christian life and not just speak about it or pretend that everything is well, when perhaps it is not. I have to be the best for you. At the same time, you have an accountability to me as well as to all others to be striving to be a strong member of the Body of Christ. You don't just need me. I need you. We need each other. That is what it means to be Church. And we need each other to be the best we can be. This weekend's readings are all about accountability. Many people will speak about having an accountability partner. Usually these people are dealing with an addiction. They meet regularly with their partner who challenges them to avoid the temptations that have dominated them in the past. This all works because the person feels obligated to their accountability partner to be better. What the readings this weekend are telling us is that as the Body of Christ, our accountability partner is the Presence of the Lord in the Community. When each of us come to a deeper sense of the Real Presence of our Lord Jesus Christ, especially his Real Presence in each other, we will all recognize our responsibility to the Lord to be the person He created us to be.
