A MESSAGE FROM FR. DEPALMA

There are the various 54-day novena Rosaries that many have begun to pray for peace and for all of the needs of our nation, communities, parishes and families. If you have not gotten into the habit of praying a daily Rosary then I would highly encourage you to do so for the Rosary is for us Catholics our secret weapon so to speak. It brings to us the blessing of a Mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary, but it's focus of course, is on her Son our Lord Jesus, fortifying us with all of the graces that we need that come from the Father. Now this is such an important combination because even as small children, and don't forget, we think that we are all grown up and know what we are doing, but in reality, so very often we don't have a clue as to how to get through the hardships and trials of this life on our own, we need the blessing of the presence of both a mother and a father. Remember when we were very young, whenever we got hurt--banged up a knee when we fell off our bike, or when we suffered the ache of a broken heart when one of our friends from school didn't want to be our friend anymore--we almost instinctively went to our mothers. A mother's comfort in times of hurt is a great thing. Well, we are living in times when we have to suffer, especially as Catholic Christians, the attacks thrown our way and so it's very hard sometimes not to get hurt as to what is going on. But, when we were scared as a child, a thunderstorm frightened us, or there were sirens that came right down the street, we instinctively ran to our fathers. A father's presence is what we needed for us to be reassured. That hasn't changed one bit for us. We live in a world that is definitely dangerous and scary. And we look around and where is there a father to run to? We have to look up and to look in. We look up to God the Father who is watching us from heaven, but also God the Father who is there dwelling inside of our hearts. And where do we have access to both the comforting presence of a mother when we are hurt, or the calming, reassuring presence of a father when we are scared? The Rosary. It is truly one of the great blessings that we have as Catholics. But the Rosary also conforms us to the heart of our Lord Jesus. So as I just mentioned, pray the Rosary daily. Some of you have awesome Rosaries that have been given to you over the years. Dust those off and get those fingers rolling over those beads! There are way too many graces waiting for you to be received.

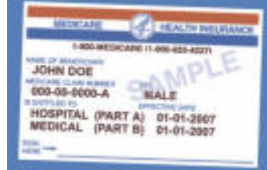
