A MESSAGE FROM FR. DEPALMA

As we take a few weeks of Ordinary Time to enjoy and to fully put into our lives the blessings of this past Christmas Season, and as we will soon, in about a month's time, prepare for the great season of Lent, we sometimes have to take a look at nature to help us get ready for the changing of seasons in the Church's liturgical year. For those of us who live in the Northern Hemisphere, we have a brief gap between the two great seasons of Christmas and Lent occurring in the middle of winter. For us here in the desert Southwest, yes, it can be cold, it can be a bit dreary, but we don't seem to mind it as much as those who might have grown up near the Great Lakes, where the steel gray skies dominate for months on end.
