Take from me the will to be lazy and sad;  
The desire to get ahead of other people  
and to boast and brag.

Give me instead a pure and humble spirit  
the will to be patient with other people  
And to love them.

Lord, let me realize my own mistakes  
And keep me from judging what other people do

# ASH WEDNESDAY

## LENT BEGINS

**WHAT IS LENT?** PRAYING FASTING ABSTINENCE

The 40-day period from Ash Wednesday and before Easter Sunday. It is marked by praying, fasting, abstinence, and other acts of penance.

---

**WHAT IS FASTING?**

One meal a day, and two smaller meals which if added together would not exceed one full meal

**WHAT IS ABSTINENCE?**

Abstinence is refraining from eating meat. Meat is considered to be the flesh and organs of mammals and fowl.

---

**DAYS OF FAST?**

Ash Wednesday Good Friday

**DAYS OF ABSTINENCE?**

Ash Wednesday All Fridays of Lent Good Friday

---

**WHO ARE REQUIRED?**

Catholics from age <18 to 59>

The sick are excused from fasting

**WHO ARE REQUIRED?**

Mandatory for everyone older than 14 years old
