A MESSAGE FROM FR. DEPALMA

This weekend we have a wonderful passage from Luke. Because Luke lets us know that Jesus seeks us out when we are troubled with doubts about ourselves, the world in which we live, the various pains that we have to deal with, when we don't know what to do, when we feel maybe that even God has abandoned us, it is Jesus who comes to us. And just like Luke shows us in today's Gospel with the Apostles, it's the same for us: he just appears. He appears in their midst and the first words he says are: "Peace. Peace be with you." Jesus will say the same to us. But what kind of peace is Jesus talking about? Not man's peace. Our peace is just calming ourselves down from one conflict while preparing for the next one to come! We get tired of destroying each other and wait for a while and then it all begins again. The peace that Jesus speaks of here is something much greater. When Jesus says to us, "Peace be with you," he doesn't mean just that peace be in your hearts, but that you are to go through the whole world and bring that peace to all the nations, even to the people who drive us crazy. And what is this peace? Well, we might think this peace is sort of an organized effort to control ourselves a little bit. Or it's a kind of a thing. Or it's a kind of a quality of life. No, what Jesus is talking about is simply this: His peace is himself. His peace is a person. His peace is God. Just like Jesus revealed that God the Father is not only a loving God, but is Love Itself, so too is Peace. It's God, it's the presence of Jesus himself. He is your peace. As we continue to go through our Easter season, may the peace of our Lord Jesus become strong and ever-present in your lives so that not only can you bring this Peace, this Presence to others, but so that you can never be disturbed, since you have grounded your life deep into this Peace.
