17TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



“There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?” Then Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed them to those who were reclining, and also as much of the fish as they wanted. - Jn 6:9, 11

A MESSAGE FROM FR. DEPALMA

This Sunday we have the Gospel of St. John and his account of our Lord Jesus multiplying the fishes and loaves of bread in the great miracle that foreshadows our Lord giving us of himself in Holy Eucharist, where we receive the Bread of Life, Jesus himself. Now one of the things that we always have to be aware of are those who put forth teachings that downplay the Faith and especially those who deny the miracles of our Lord, even if those teachings come from other Catholics, even Catholic priests. One of the teachings on this story that has been going around in the past couple of decades is that there wasn't a true miracle of fish and bread being multiplied, but rather, once the people saw Jesus sharing the few fish and the bread with others, the people suddenly became full of this spirit of sharing and thus, they shared what they had with others, so that the "miracle" was not the actual multiplication of fish and bread but rather in how the people were overcome with the need to share what they had. This is actually a dangerous teaching for if you deny the power of the Lord, then what else are you going to deny? Besides, it is very easy to show that all of the people sharing didn't happen. First, if you look at the actual words of St. John, and it's always good to go the text of the Bible and see what it actually says, and keep in mind, St. John was right there for this miracle, it is stated that "Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed them to those who were reclining..." Jesus himself gave out the food to all who were reclining. Ok, so who were reclining? All of them! Jesus told all of those thousands of people there to recline. So it was our Lord who gave to all. That could only of happened if there was a miracle, a multiplication of fish and bread. Second, as we will see in the Gospels after this miracle, when Jesus and the Apostles crossed over to the other side of the Sea of Galilee, the people followed them and wanted to make Jesus their king. Why? There is no way they would do that if Jesus simply inspired them to share. They were looking for Jesus for some more free food! They wanted him to be king so that they would never be hungry again. That definitely points to this being a miracle. But finally, all four of the Gospels mention this event and they all describe it as a miracle. That's no coincidence. This Gospel is our Lord showing not only his power as God and also his care for the people, but this is an enormous foreshadowing of how Jesus feeds all of us through the Bread that is Holy Communion. So celebrate all that our Lord Jesus has done and is doing for us, and at the same time, be always aware of teachings that don't line up with the tradition of either the Church or of the Sacred Scriptures.
