## A MESSAGE FROM FR. DEPALMA

With the feast of St. Matthew coming up this next Tuesday, he of course is one of the four Evangelists, a writer of one of the Gospels. This should be a good reminder to all of us Catholics that one of the greatest sources of power, grace, and support that God can give to us comes from our reading of the Holy Scriptures. Now there is that image which has become rather cliché where our non-Catholic Christian brothers and sisters can quote all sorts of verses from the Bible, but here we are as Catholics, as if we are missing some sort of gene, unable to remember anything but the most famous of Scripture verses! But the Bible is a Catholic book. A great booklet that you could pick up and read, and it's actually free to download online is by Jimmy Akin entitled "The Bible is a Catholic Book."

Here is short excerpt from his introduction to his booklet:

"The Bible can be intimidating. It's a big, thick book—much longer than most books people read. It's also ancient. The most recent part of it was penned almost 2,000 years ago. That means it's not written in a modern style. It can seem strange and unfamiliar to a contemporary person. Even more intimidating is that it shows us our sins and makes demands on our lives. No wonder some people hesitate to take the plunge and start reading the Bible! But each of the things that can make it intimidating is actually a benefit: • Because the Bible is so large, it contains a great deal of valuable information. If it were short, it wouldn't tell us nearly as much. • The fact that it was written so long ago testifies to its timeless message. Its teachings aren't tied to just one time or culture. They have endured, and by reading Scripture we experience the joy of discovering the story of God's dealings with mankind. • Finally, it's important that it reveals our sins to us. We need wake-up calls that shake us out of our feeble attempts THE BIBLE IS A CATHOLIC BOOK to rationalize what we're doing wrong. And Scripture is quick to assure of us God's love for us. "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life" (John 3:16).

Become more and more inspired to read the Sacred Word and may our Lord Jesus continue to bless you through his Word.
