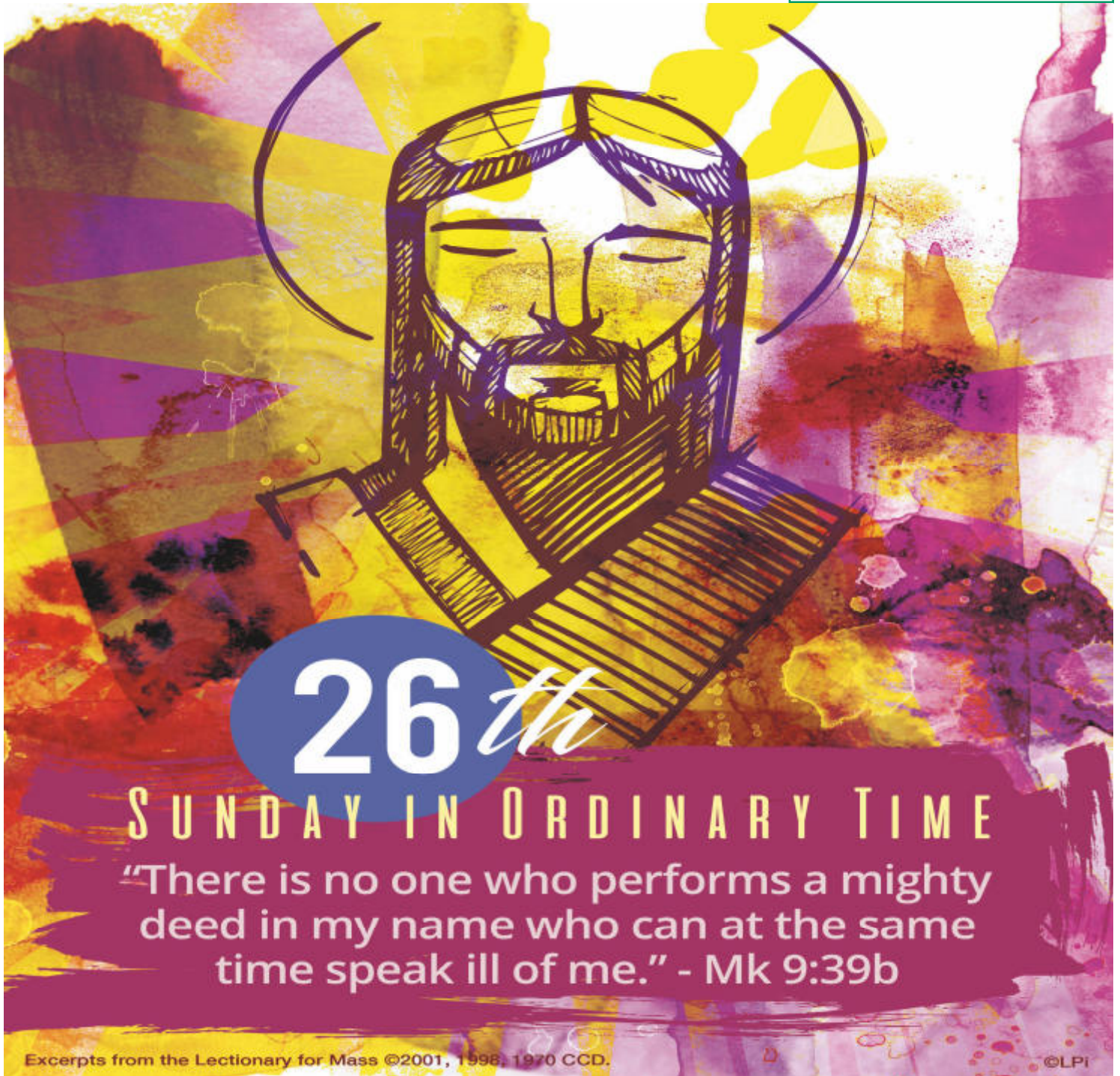

A MESSAGE FROM FR. DEPALMA

So, when you are doing your prayers throughout the day, and perhaps most especially at night, do you include prayers for our parish? Now as your pastor I pray for you all and your families every day, but during my night prayers I also pray for the safety and protection from God for our parish buildings and property. We live in some difficult times and part of the difficulty that we face are not just the day to day ups and downs, but we have to be always ready to be praying for the spiritual protection that all of us need, but especially for our parish. I know and greatly appreciate that a lot of you do just that and those prayers were answered in a very dramatic way this past Friday. I left the confessional a little after 8:00am and everything was fine, but coming back from breakfast around 9:00am, I could smell something definitely burning and it was an electrical burn. Some of the staff and I were able to locate the part of the building where the smell was coming from, and it was a bit unnerving to see some smoke coming in through the vents in the music room. So we called the fire department and they were able to locate the problem to one of our furnaces near the east entrance to the building. They disconnected the units and we had the HVAC company come over and they discovered that one of the blowers to the unit was catching on fire. They told me, with eyes quite wide open, that the fire could have jumped through the electrical system and started the whole complex on fire. God literally saved our church this past Friday. Could you imagine if this had taken place at 9:00 at night instead of in the morning? God has been very good to us here at the Newman Center. But God has not just been good to us in our receiving of personal grace, but totally faithful to us in the blessing of corporate graces, the graces that bless all of us as a parish. So let us double up our prayers of protection for all of us, but don't forget to include asking for God's protection for our buildings and property.

May you all have a very blessed week and let's keep praying for our upcoming fiesta in two week that we will have another very blessed event through the graciousness of our Lord Jesus.
