During these unprecedented times of uncertainty and crisis, we continue to assess all the ways to further our shared mission to strengthen the Body of Christ in the Diocese of Kalamazoo and continue the good works of the Church.

In an effort to assist Parishes in securing financial stability Bishop Bradley authorized a significant change in the distribution of Bishop's Annual Appeal funds:



All gifts donated beyond 50 percent of the Parish's goal will be returned to the Parish.



While this will require shared sacrifice we believe Strong Parishes equal a Strong Diocese and together we will confront our challenges and persevere in hope.



New this year - 2020: \$1.7 M - 50% of this year's goal will be directed back to the Parishes (+ all monies raised over Parish targets)

EXAMPLE:

Parish Goal = \$100, Parish meets goal plus raises \$25 beyond goal.

Diocese keeps \$50, Parish receives \$75


