Dear Friends:

Our unique Lenten journey this year has brought us to today, Easter Sunday, the holiest day of the liturgical year. The true message is that Jesus has lived and died and risen for us. He is the source of our salvation, especially in these difficult times. He is Risen. Three words that changed everything.

We continue to pray for all those in the medical field, first responders and all those working to keep food and other necessities available to us. We pray too for all the victims of the COVID-19 pandemic and their families. Jesus carried his cross for us and tells us that we need to carry our crosses, no matter how difficult they may be. Jesus promises to be with us to share our burdens and provide support for us along the way. God loves us beyond all measure.

We trust in Christ's promise to remain with us always. In the joyful spirit of Easter, myself along with Fr. Mullan, Msgr. Flanigan and Deacon Betzal pray that Our Risen Lord will bestow upon you and your family the peace and happiness, which He alone can give.

May we who have the flexibility to care for our children when their schools close remember those who have no options.

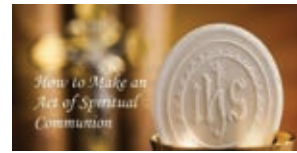
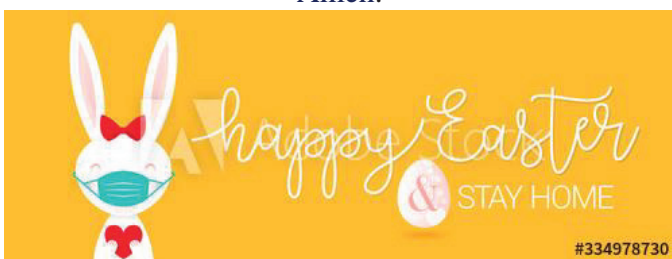
May we who have to cancel our trips remember those who have no safe place to go.
