In this day and age, it is all too easy to view each other with suspicion or at least a certain guardedness. Of course, it's wise to be prudent in our dealings with people. But stewardship calls us to a different outlook towards others. This is the attitude our heavenly Father has when He looks upon creation, as we see in our first reading, from the Book of Wisdom. Jesus models this transforming hospitality in His encounter with Zacchaeus, the tax collector, in today's Gospel reading from Luke. This was a gesture of intimacy and true fellowship in that day and culture. Jesus saw the goodness within the man.
