### ABSTINENCE AND OTHER ACTS OF PENANCE FOR LENT

The Bishops of the United States prescribe, as minimal obligation, that all persons who are fourteen years of age or older are bound to abstain from eating meat all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday. Further, all persons eighteen years of age and older, up to and including their fifty-ninth birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single meal on Good Friday, while the other two meals on that day are to be light.

All the faithful are encouraged, when possible, to participate at Mass and to receive the Holy Eucharist daily, to celebrate frequently the Sacrament of Penance, to undertake spiritual reading, especially the study of the Sacred Scriptures, and to participate in parish Lenten devotions as well as Lenten education programs. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is especially recommended. All are encouraged to make some material sacrifices during Lent and give that money to the poor. Please use our poor boxes.

### INSTALLATION OF ARCHBISHOP PEREZ

Accompanied by solemn prayers, lively hymns in English and Spanish, and an uproarious over-flow crowd at the Basilica, Nelson J. Perez was installed as the fourteenth Bishop of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.

The ceremony began with Archbishop Chaput seated in the cathedra (Bishop's Chair). He asks that the Apostolic letter be shown to the College of Consultors and then be read by the Most Reverend Christophe Pierre, the Papal Nuncio to the United States. After the reading of Pope Francis' letter Archbishop Chaput and the Nuncio lead Archbishop Perez to the cathedra where he is greeted by some members of the clergy and the faithful of the Archdiocese. Interfaith, ecumenical leaders and civil servants also greet the Archbishop.

We are grateful for great leadership and service that Archbishop Chaput gave to the Church during these difficult times. I think that Archbishop Perez said it well in his homily. "He was steadfast, and he made decisions that sometimes a father has to make. Decisions that sometimes drew him great sufferings and criticism. The Archdiocese of Philadelphia owes this man an incredible debt of gratitude for who he was, is, and continues to be."

We thank Archbishop for his gift to the church and wish him a long, happy and productive retirement!

Let us keep Archbishop Perez in our prayers as he begins his ministry.
