## Sacraments

**Penance:** Saturday from 4:00 - 4:45 PM in the Main Church. Other times on request.

**Baptism:** English Baptisms will be officiated on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month at 1:30 PM in the Church.

Spanish Baptisms will be officiated on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month at 1:30 PM in the Church.

Contact the Parish Office to schedule. Attendance at Baptism class is mandatory.

### First Penance, First Eucharist and Confirmation:

Though immediate preparation is given before receiving these sacraments, children are expected to receive a Catholic upbringing in their families. This includes formal religious education classes and regular Sunday worship in the years prior to and following the reception of these Sacraments.

**Marriage:** Weddings are celebrated Friday evenings and Saturdays, but not Sundays. You must contact a priest nine months before the planned date, and reservation of a wedding time is suggested even earlier.

## Devotions

**Marian Novena:** Saturdays following 8:30 AM Mass in the Chapel.

**Eucharistic Adoration:** First Friday of the month from 9 AM -12 PM, Benediction in English in the Chapel. Second Friday of the month from 6:30-8:30 PM, Benediction in Spanish in the Chapel.

## In the Hospital?

If you or someone you know is sick in the hospital or nursing home for an extended stay, please contact the parish office. We will do our best to have someone make a pastoral visit and bring communion.

## New Parishioners

New Parishioners are asked to come to the Parish Office and fill out a Census form. Individuals and families must be registered and practicing here for at least six months before applying for sponsorship.

**If you have changed your address** or other information, please contact the Parish Office at (732) 356-0027 so that we can update our records.

## Sponsorship Eligibility

**To be or not to be a Sponsor for Baptism or Confirmation?** It is important to think carefully about your selection and decision. The person to be considered a Sponsor must be at least 14 years of age and have themselves completed the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation), and are leading a life in harmony with the Faith and Tradition they are called to witness. A Godparent/Sponsor cannot be the mother or father of the one to be baptized. If married, their marriage must be recognized as "valid" by the Catholic Church. They must be attending Mass regularly, that is, every Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation. **They will need to obtain a Certificate of Eligibility signed by their pastor.** If you have questions, speak with a parish priest who can guide you correctly. Call the Parish Office early, even before your child's birth to obtain information that will help you in selecting suitable godparents.

## Today's Readings

### Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

#### Reading I: Isaiah 49: 3, 5-6

The prophet presents himself as another Jeremiah, with references to having a call while still in the womb, and his obligation to fulfill it. He knows that he is to be "a light to the nations" with his announcements.

#### Reading II: I Corinthians 1: 1-3

Paul uses a standard letter introduction, and then claims to have the same apostolic authority as the original Twelve. He tells his readers that they have been set apart by God and must work to be worthy of that.

#### The Gospel: John 1: 29-34

The writer tells his readers that the descent of the Spirit upon Jesus was the sign for John the Baptist that He was the one designated by God. He is "the Lamb of God" with all the rich meaning of that term making Him the ultimate sacrifice for our sins.

## New Deadline Established for NJ Independent Victim Compensation Program

The Diocese of Metuchen is among the five Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey to announce a six-week extension for those, who as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest or deacon of the Diocese, who may still want to file a claim through the Independent Victims Compensation Program (IVCP). The deadline for the registration of new allegations has been extended until January 31, while the deadline for the submission of all claims has been extended until February 15. Those survivors, who as minors were the victim of clergy sexual abuse and who now wish to pursue a claim through the IVCP, can begin the claims process by going to [www.NJdiocesesIVCP.com](http://www.NJdiocesesIVCP.com).

The IVCP operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution and the administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims, no matter when the abuse occurred, are eligible to participate. All matters will be handled confidentially. Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to [www.njdiocesesivcp.com](http://www.njdiocesesivcp.com) and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim. Anyone who is a survivor of sexual abuse by a priest or deacon of the Diocese is encouraged to participate in the IVCP.

## 2020 Call to Action Day

Over 120,000 postcards have been mailed to our NJ State Legislators over the past year urging them to pass the "Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act" which would ban abortion past 20 weeks gestation in NJ by the year 2020. Studies show that this is when babies in the womb feel pain. We are asking everyone to call your New Jersey State Legislators (Senator and two Assemblymen/women) on January 24 and ask them for their response to our postcards. There are currently no restrictions on abortion in New Jersey at all! Urge them to advance this bill (A3452/S2026) now!
