SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Infant/Child Baptism: Baptism is our incorporation into the Body of Christ and the foundation of our sacramental life. Contact Ana Valencia at the parish center to begin the process of instruction and celebration.

Children's Penance/Eucharist/Confirmation: Preparation for these sacraments of initiation are handled within our Faith Formation program. For questions, contact Ana Valencia.

Adult Initiation: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the path for those seeking to learn more and perhaps ask for full initiation into the Catholic church. A related process is available for those adults who only need to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. For initial questions, contact any clergy person of the parish.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Penance: this Sacrament is celebrated Saturday from 4:00-4:30pm in the Church. Other times are available by making an appointment with parish priests.

Anointing of the Sick: freely offered to those who are sick, facing surgery, those with chronic mental or emotional illness, and those of advanced age. In the Covid-19 era, there are certain conditions that prevent clergy from home visits and hospitals, but contact Fr. Blicharski at the parish if you would like the sacrament and we can determine if we can celebrate it safely.

SACRAMENTS OF SERVICE

Christian Marriage: Congratulations and blessings on your engagement. Every couple has unique gifts and needs, and our clergy will walk and work with you to meet our own time-tested standards to get you to the altar and beyond. Contact anyone on the pastoral team.

Holy Orders: If you are sensing God's call to service as a priest or deacon in the church, contact our pastor and/or any parish team member you feel can best serve you. Similarly, even though there are no sacraments associated with the religious life, monastic life, lay ministry or faith-based humanitarian service, please contact us if we can help you in your discernment.

DEVOTIONS

First Friday Mass in Time of Pandemic: For every First Friday of the Month, the parish will offer a bilingual "Mass in Time of Pandemic" at 7:00 PM. Next: November 6.

First and Last Friday Eucharistic Adoration: Every First Friday morning of the month, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will run from 9:00 AM - Noon in the church. Starting Friday, October 30 and continuing for every Last Friday of the month, an evening Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will be offered from 5:00 PM - 7:00 PM. The language of Adoration is "Silence."

Monthly St. Sharbel Healing Mass: Starting Thursday, October 22 at 7:00 PM and continuing every 22nd of the month, a bilingual healing Mass will be offered, focusing on the intercession of St. Sharbel, the hermit of Lebanon, who is the subject of increasing devotion throughout the world.

Marian Devotion: first Friday Angelus, 12 noon monthly, at the conclusion of Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

RESTORATION OF PUBLIC MASSES

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

We celebrate World Mission Sunday today, October 18. This annual, worldwide Eucharistic celebration emphasizes our shared baptismal call to be missionaries in our own right.

Pope Francis reminds us during the Mission Month of October that, as baptized Christians, we are called personally to mission – especially at this time – to bring Christ's life to those most forgotten around the world. You too can be sent out to all the ends of the earth – sent through your support of missionaries and mission dioceses in Asia, Africa, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe as they proclaim the Gospel, build the Church, and serve the poor. With them, you answer "Here I am, Send Me."

TODAY'S READINGS

TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Reading I: Isaiah 45: 1, 4-6

The prophet imagines Yahweh grasping the hand of Cyrus, according to accepted custom for accepting a new king. Instead, Cyrus actually takes the hand of a pagan deity. Yet the Lord is king and there is no other. He is Lord of history.

Reading II: I Thessalonians 1: 1-5

Paul thanks God for the fruitful reception people of this town gave to his preaching. He tells of a gospel having both power and strength to tie the community in true unity.

The Gospel: Matthew 22: 15-21

This attempt at an entrapment of Jesus by the Pharisees and the Herodians fails miserably. The Roman taxes were despised by the Jews because they marked the Jews as a conquered people. Jesus here implicitly accepts the notion that the state is the lesser of two evils.

OCTOBER EXPERIMENTAL EVENING SCHEDULE

Starting October 1, a new experimental and *a la carte* evening parish prayer schedule has begun. **Most importantly, we have introduced a 7:00 PM Mass in Spanish that will run from Monday-Friday as long as parishioner demand warrants the Mass.** Parishioners can also choose to come at 6:00 PM Monday-Friday for a 20-minute period of silent contemplative prayer led by Msgr. Kerrigan or other clergy. At 6:30 PM, the evening prayer of the church, "Vespers," will be conducted in Spanish.

Parishioners are invited to attend one, two or all three of the services; they are separate events. But parishioners are also advised to enter (main center) door and exit (side doors) in the same uni-directional pattern that we use for Mass.

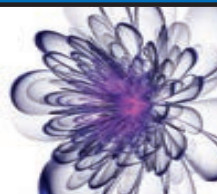
