Also check if the message comes from an address other than mmolony@comcell.net. If you look closely, it is usually NOT the 940 area code. If Father ever wants you to do something financially or otherwise, he will contact you in person. **This is a scam so please be careful to what you are responding to!! Just beware and be safe.**
