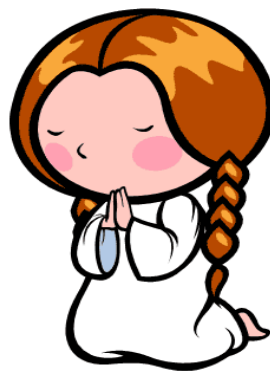
CATECHISM IN A YEAR
