SCOTLAND-WINDTHORST VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS (VFW) POST 2676 is sponsoring "Voice of Democracy and Patriot's Pen Scholarship competitions, and the Citizenship Teacher of the Year award. In the voice of Democracy, high school students must write and record a 3 to 5 minute essay on "**What Makes America Great**" and present their recording, typed essay and completed entry form to Post 2676 by Oct. 31st. The Post winners will earn scholarship money of \$300 for 1st place, \$150 for 2nd and \$75 for 3rd. The Post winner then competes at the district level and the winner advancing to the state competition. State winners will receive an all-expense trip to Washington, D.C. and receive their portion of \$154,000 in national awards, the top scholarship being \$30,000.

The Patriot's Pen essay competition is for students in grades 6-8. This competition challenges students to write a 300 to 400 word essay on a patriotic theme. The theme for 2019-2020 is "**What Makes America Great.**" They can earn scholarship money of \$150 for 1st place, \$75 for 2nd place & \$50 for 3rd. Winners will advance to the District competition. Those winners will advance to on to State competition.

The Citizenship Teacher of the Year award recognizes elementary, junior high and high school teachers who teach citizenship education topics regularly and promote America's history/traditions effectively. Post 2676 will select one teacher in each category who will be awarded \$100 each. Winners will advance to District competition with the chance of earning state and national awards. Nominations can be submitted by fellow teachers, supervisors or other interested individuals (not relatives).

Official entry forms are due to Post 2676 by Oct. 31, 2019. Eligibility requirements/official entry forms can be obtained from your school counselors or principals or by emailing the Post 2676 Program Chairman, David Teichman, at dateichman@gmail.com or by phone at 940-636-1566
