**DIOCESAN HISTORY BOOK** – The story of an intrepid 500 year faith journey in Texas that led to the creation of the Diocese of Fort Worth. ### **PRECEPTS OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH**

1 You shall attend Mass on Sundays and on holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor. We must "sanctify the day commemorating the resurrection of the Lord" (Sunday), as well as the principal feast days, known as Catholic holy days of obligation (catholic-holy-days-of-obligation). This requires attending Mass, "and by resting from those works and activities which could impede such a sanctification of these days."

2 You shall confess your sins at least once a year. We must prepare for the Eucharist by means of the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession). This sacrament "continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness."

3 You shall receive the sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter season. This "guarantees as a minimum the reception of the Lord's Body and Blood in connection with the Paschal feasts, the origin and center of the Christian liturgy."

4 You shall observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church. "The fourth precept ensures the times of asceticism and penance which prepare us for the liturgical feasts and help us acquire mastery over our instincts and freedom of heart."

5 You shall help to provide for the needs of the Church. "The fifth precept means that the faithful are obliged to assist with the material needs of the Church, each according to his own ability."

Note that these precepts of the Catholic Church are required, unless you have a legitimate reason for not meeting them. For example:

If you are sick, tending to a sick child, or camping in the wilderness on Sunday and cannot get to Mass, it is not a grave violation to miss Mass that day.

Children, the elderly, and pregnant or nursing women do not have to fast on normal fast days (Ash Wednesday and Good Friday).

**SECURITY NOTICE:** When the children leave the church for Children's Liturgy at the 10:30 AM Mass, one of the ushers escorts the leaders and the children to the Convent, and sees to it that they are all inside the Convent. The usher returns to Church, locking the Church door behind him. The leaders of the Children's Liturgy are locking the Convent door once inside. When Father completes the sermon, an usher, goes back to the Convent and escorts the leaders and children back to Church, locking the Church doors again once inside. Hope this clears up any concern regarding the security of our parishioners. Thank you. Father Michael.

If the center pews are full, ushers will then instead usher late comers to opening places in the rear short pews on the south side or if preferred to the cry room.

The current two pews reserved as "Parents with Children" are now moved forward by two pews.

Users will sit in the two small pews on the right side as you enter the Church. See "Usher" sign on the rear short pews.

**DIVORCED AND RE-MARRIED?** If you are divorced and remarried outside of the Catholic Church without a Decree of Nullity/Invalidity, or if you are a Catholic and are married outside of the Catholic Church, you may not partake of the Sacraments, including the reception of Holy Communion. Until it is shown otherwise through the ministry of the Tribunal, no person is free to enter into another marriage without the appearance or occasion of serious sin. However, a divorce alone does not affect or hinder in any way, your participation in the Sacraments. A divorced Catholic is free to receive the sacraments. However, if you are divorced and have remarried, or if you are divorced and in a new relationship, or if you are living with someone without a Decree of Nullity/Invalidity (and your former spouse is still living) you may not partake of the sacraments, including the reception of Holy Communion). Consider seeking a Decree of Nullity/Invalidity which will enable you to return to a full participation in the sacramental life of the Church.
