I understand that all activities have certain risks and could result in injury to the above child. I further specifically waive, release, and discharge the Diocese of Cleveland, **St. Albert the Great School and Parish**, and the employees and volunteers of the aforesaid school, parish, and/or diocese from all claims arising out of and/or resulting from harm, bodily injury, loss of life or property, damages and losses sustained by the child while participating in the above field trip, including claims of the child's parents and/or next of kin and/or (if applicable) guardian. I further agree to indemnify the Diocese of Cleveland, **St. Albert the Great School and Parish**, and the employees/volunteers of the aforesaid school, parish, Diocese and/or their employees/volunteers as a result of injury or damage suffered by the above child and/or the child's parents and/or next of kin and/or (if applicable) guardian, arising out of the child's participation in the field trip. Furthermore, I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to provide adequate health insurance for the above child.

I fully understand what is involved in the field trip and I understand that I have the opportunity to contact the teacher and ask him/her about the field trip.

I have read and fully understand the contents of this entire document and consent to the provisions contained therein.

Saint Albert the Great Ski Club Rules

The following rules have been established so that Ski Club can run smoothly and can be fun. It is important that your good faith as a member of Ski Club be shown by reading and understanding the rules. Both the student and parent must sign and return this form.

1. Ski club is on Friday. Bus leaves the school at 3:45 pm and returns at 9:00 pm.
 - a. Students must leave the slopes no later than 8:10 pm and be on the bus by 8:20 pm.
 - b. Parents must be at the school for pick up in Lot B at 9:00 pm.
2. Any student not on the bus at 8:20 pm will forfeit their ski privilege the next session.
 - a. A student who is late a second time will not be able to ride the bus to and from Brandywine for the rest of the season. No refunds on bus money.
3. Ski Rental Equipment must be returned to its proper place at Brandywine or you will be charged full price to replace.
4. Students are expected to adhere to the rules and regulations as written in the St. Albert the Great Handbook.
5. All Skiers must obey rules that are established by Brandywine and the National Ski patrol.
6. It is expected that each Skier will wait their turn in the lift lines and exercise courteous and careful behavior on the slopes. REMEMBER skiers are responsible for themselves on the slopes and under Ohio Law are liable for accidents caused by skiing out of control.
7. Any disruptive behavior on the part of the student, failure to adhere to the rules established by Brandywine or the rules in the School Code of Conduct or any of the above rules will result in loss of Ski Privileges. Loss of Privilege means loss of money. There will be no refunds.
8. The Ski Card Lanyard you receive on the First Night of Ski Club must be worn around your neck at all times. It will be collected at the end of each session and returned to you on the bus for the next session. Replacement Tags cost \$25.00
9. Lessons - **Ski Club members are required to take their lesson each week.** All Club member's club cards must be validated with at least one color-coded lesson sticker indicating the member's ability level. **ALL members must have a lesson sticker on their neck tag by the end of week two, this includes returning members.** NO EXCEPTIONS. If lessons are not taken, skiing privileges will be lost for the following week.
10. **Students must return on the bus with SKI CLUB unless they are in the custody of their parents or legal guardian.**
 - If you plan on picking your child up at BRANDYWINE you **must fill out the form** on the school website and send it with your child on the day of Ski Club (Forms must be in the office by 10:00 am on the morning of SKI CLUB) **OR** Come to the **Ski Lodge by 7:45 pm** and sign out your child. (You may not sign out any other students)
11. Only ski club members are allowed to use bus transportation. Attendance will be taken as students enter the bus at school and at Brandywine.
12. Cell Phone Usage - Students may bring their cell phones to school on Ski Club days. Phones brought to school/ski club are the responsibility of the student. Cell phones must be turned off during the school day. The school is not responsible for lost or stolen phones.
13. Helmets are strongly encouraged for snowboarders. Helmets can be rented weekly at Brandywine for \$10.00/visit.
14. Please check the BMBW website Friday morning before ski club to insure the area is open. Regardless of the conditions, if the area is open for skiing, our club will attend.

You will be notified if skiing is cancelled during the day, Friday. The school has the right to cancel Ski Club due to dangerous weather conditions.
15. At no time shall a club member be by themselves, the "BUDDY SYSTEM" is required.
16. Students are responsible for any personal equipment and belongings they bring to Ski Club. Equipment will be stored in a storage room during school. Clothing is taken to the classrooms.
17. Students are responsible for securing their belongings at Brandywine. **Lockers are available for \$1.00 token.** Every time the locker is opened you must insert another \$1.00 token. Personal belongings are not to be left on the floor.
18. Students are responsible for bringing money to purchase food and beverages.
19. ALL NEW Ski Club Participants and a Parent must attend a meeting on: Thursday, December 5th at 7:00 PM in the School Cafeteria.
