Enclosed are a list of things I'd like you to accomplish this summer.

Familiarize yourself with the Common Literary Terms and Common Genre worksheets. We will be incorporating this information in our discussions throughout the year. These terms will be included in assessments next year. Keep these papers in your enrichment reading binder.

I am including a list of great books you should enjoy. Be prepared to report on one of these books in September. I recommend choosing one that is an AR title and get a jump start on your points for next year.

I encourage you to journal daily. Keep a journal nearby and write in it at least 3 times a week. Reflect on a book you are reading, or have your parents find a list of writing prompts for the days you may need a bit of inspiration.

Read for 20 minutes a day. Read books that you love!
