5. Pastor Comments – **Fr. McCullough**
 - a. Sunday evening prayer services are tentatively scheduled for – 12/15, 1/5, 3/29, and 4/26
 - b. The confessional will be installed between the chapel and the “Cry Room”. Alan Bossman finished the plans.
 - i. Funds have been secured
 - ii. Plans have been submitted for Greenhills approval
 - iii. October completion had been targeted. This will need to be scheduled according to Clem’s schedule.
 - c. Fundraising will start with targeted donor meetings on October 23rd and 30th. A presentation and walk-through will be included. Jim K nice presentation.
 - i. The stated goal is \$200,000, but there will be disappointment if this is not surpassed. Once we finish on the 30th, we will assess where we are and how the fund-raising roll-out will continue.

- d. Antiphons, Hymnals, what to do with “Gather”. Update? We hoped to start this in Advent, but currently there is not time to catechize. This will give us time to catechize on it and take some hints from other parishes already starting. We want to take the time to give folks time to learn and understand the change.
- e. Faith Formation
 - i. Dan Egan presented “Catholics and Evangelism” on September 30 – It was a success
 - ii. The Oct 7 parish feast day celebration went well with a Mass and procession to the grotto area where the rosary was prayed. It was a success. Next year we need to consider those folks who aren’t able to process with the Rosary.
 - iii. An Interior Life series will be conducted on Tuesdays by John Leyendecker and David Scales. The series starts on Oct 15 and continues through Nov 19. It has been a success. About 90 participants. Good representation from all 3 parishes. Consider doing a series on a liturgical rhythm- something in the fall, Advent, Lent and summer. Spiritual growth looking into Christmas book and a Pentecost vigil.
 - iv. The region’s Lenten Mission will be at OLR in 2020 and will be conducted by the Fathers of Mercy. This mission will actually be held before Lent (2020’s Ash Wednesday is Feb 26). Date-February 2-5, 2020
 - v. I GIVE CATHOLIC-December 3 with a 2-week advanced period. Conversation to continue through email.
 - vi. Fr. meeting in December to discuss sharing a Spanish speaking priest with a few parishes. Spanish Mass attendance and the collection is growing. This makes it financially feasible for us.
 - vii. Fr. will host 3 1-hour trainings for ministry leaders, 1 per parish.
