7. OLR Finances (Budgets run from July 1 – June 30) – **Dave Crowe**

The impact of Spanish Mass collections was not factored in to the 2019-2020 budget. It could account for a 3% lift in the Sunday collections.

Discussions are underway to identify the fundraising goal for the 2019 #iGiveCatholic campaign.

Year end

Sunday income finished down 1.5% against budget, but the success of the #iGiveCatholic campaign far exceeded the shortfall.

Wage and health insurance savings were realized after not rehiring to replace an open administrative position.

Facility repairs ran over budget for the year; a more realistic number for repairs has been factored into the 2019-2020 budget.

Parish finished \$36K favorable this budget year.

Checking account balance is stable. Some accrued savings were transferred down to our savings instruments at the Archdiocese.
