6. Pastor Comments

- a. The organ is in-use and its official blessing occurred on July 7.
 - i. A “demonstration concert” by the supplier is still planned (TBD date)
- b. A quarterly Sunday evening prayer service is being considered.
- c. The Fundraising Committee will have its initial meeting on July 19
- d. Spanish Mass status
 - i. Attendance has been in the 80-100 range
 - ii. There is a wedding booked in 2020

- iii. Karla Eysoldt, a representative from the Archdiocese Latino Ministry office, will be present for a few masses to help with registrations, etc.
 - e. The confessional will be installed between the chapel and the "Cry Room"
 - i. Funds have been secured
 - ii. Plans have been submitted for Greenhills approval
 - iii. October target completion
 - f. Faith Formation
 - i. A 6-week series on Interior Life will be conducted by John Leyendecker, timing TBD
 - ii. Sacred Heart radio has been contacted about conducting a parish visit
 - iii. The region's Lenten Mission will be at OLR in 2020 and will be conducted by the Fathers of Mercy. Due to their demand, this mission will actually be held before Lent (2020's Ash Wednesday is Feb 26).

- 7. Rummage Sale Update
 - a. \$2,300 in pre-sales
 - b. \$5,900-6,000 total! (compares favorably to Fish Fry \$5,987 non-sponsorship profit)
 - c. Ran for two Saturdays – June 29 & July 6
 - d. Three truck loads donated to St Vincent dePaul
 - e. Great effort by Mike & Debbie Day and others!

- 8. OLR Finances (Budgets run from July 1 – June 30)
 - a. 2018-2019 Results through April (10-months)
 - i. Income:
 - Sunday and Holy Day collections are +1% to budget and -2% vs PY
 - Overall +4% to budget and +2% vs PY
 - ii. Expenses
 - Total -10% vs budget, -15% vs PY
 - Facility expenses +17% vs budget, +50% vs PY (over budget due to boiler issues and school building repairs and over PY due to addition of full-time OLR maintenance person)
 - iii. Overall
 - +\$44.6 Actual, +\$20K vs budget, flat vs PY
 - b. 2019-2020 Budget
 - i. Shared services will be split equally among the three parishes. This is a change from the past. Prior budgets in the Winton-Wyoming Region era had St Matthias with a smaller share than OLR and St James.
