Parishes of St. James the Less and Our Lady of Nativity in Pikwakanagan plan to resume the Weekend Mass Schedule on Saturday February 13<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. at St. James the Less, and Sunday February 14, 2021 at 9 a.m. at Nativity of our Lady Mission in Pikwakanagan, and 11 a.m. at St. James the Less. Respecting Covid 19 regulations, we are permitted 30% capacity in our parishes, therefore 100 people are permitted inside St. James the Less and 32 people are permitted inside Nativity of our Lady Mission.

**Ash Wednesday mass for Wednesday, February 17<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m.** will take place with Fr. Bill Kenney presiding. Ashes will be distributed to anyone that chooses. Due to Covid 19, there will be a general blessing before hand, but no speaking during the distribution of ashes. Nativity of our Lady Parishioners and St. Ann's Parishioners are invited and encouraged to join, for this mass at St. James the Less.
