- For what is this Saint a patron?
- What are a couple of interesting things about this Saint?
- What about this person's life made them a saint?
- What struggles did they go through?
- Are there any symbols associated with this Saint?
- Why did you select this Saint for your Confirmation name?
- How does this Saint challenge you to be a stronger Christian?

You will need to bring your letter to the Bishop and Saint Report to your Confirmation Interview with the Priest scheduled between April 5-April 11.
