CHAPTER 10: Called to Serve (pages 155–164)

Key Concept: God calls every person to a vocation. Through your vocation, you can help God increase his Reign.

Catholic Faith Words: *vocation, Kingdom of God, vows, laity*

Discover: Everyone has a vocation—a call to be a sign of the Kingdom of God.

- ➡ A vocation is God’s plan for our lives; the purpose we are made for.
