#### **CHAPTER 9: Honoring God (pages 141–150)**

**Key Concept:** The first three Commandments teach you to honor God above all else, respect his name, and worship him on Sunday. These Commandments tell you to believe in, trust, and love God.

**Catholic Faith Words:** *worship, idolatry, blasphemy, Resurrection*

**Discover:** Jesus taught us that when we care for the least of our brothers and sisters, we care for him. Respecting others is one way we give glory to God.

- ➔ The First Commandment teaches us to worship and honor only God, and not to place things or other people before him.
- ➔ The Second Commandment says to use God's name with respect.
- ➔ The Third Commandment says to honor God by keeping Sundays holy. Keeping these Commandments is a way to grow closer to God.
