#### **CHAPTER 6: Making Good Choices (pages 107–116)**

**Key Concept:** God’s grace helps us use reason and free will to make good choices. Conscience is our God-given ability that helps us judge right from wrong.

**Catholic Faith Words:** *free will, grace, conscience*

**Discover:** We just learned how our actions help us to live in friendship with each other. Now we’ll hear more about how God gives us the freedom to choose to live in friendship with him and others. A well developed conscience helps you avoid sin and reminds us that everyone is a neighbor to be loved and respected.
