CHAPTER 3: God's Commandments (pages 73–82)

Key Concept: God gave you the Ten Commandments to help you be faithful to him and his covenant. The Commandments tell you ways to love God and others.

Catholic Faith Words: *Ten Commandments, ark of the covenant*
