CHAPTER 19: The Call to Serve (pages 257–266)

Key Concept: Through Baptism, all of us are called to spread the Gospel and build up the Body of Christ. The Sacraments at the Service of Communion are Holy Orders and Matrimony.

Discover:

- Please Pray the “**Morning Prayer**”: “*God be in my head, and in my understanding; God be in my eyes, and in my looking; God be in my mouth, and in my speaking; God be in my heart, and in my thinking; God be at my end, and at my departing. Amen.*”

 - The four states of life to which people are called are the priesthood, married life, single life, and religious life.
