### Morality

#### CHAPTER 14: New Life in Christ (pages 199–208)

**Key Concept:** Through the Sacraments of Initiation, we enter into a relationship with Christ and celebrate membership in the Catholic Church. Confirmation seals us with the Holy Spirit and deepens the grace of Baptism.

**Catholic Faith Words:** *Confirmation, Sacred Chrism*

**Discover:** God is with us in difficult times, and in good ones. God cares so much about us that he shares his life with us.

- Baptism gives us a share in God’s life; Confirmation and Eucharist help us sustain this new life. God’s grace is a gift, but we must cooperate with grace by turning away from sin. Through the Seven Sacraments God shares His divine life with us.
- Read pages 200-201: What new life is given at Baptism?
- Read the Scripture on page 201: Freedom for Sin; Life in God. Romans 6:10-11  
“Dying” to sin and “rising” to new life connects us to Christ.

Grace: God gives grace to us because He loves us!

Conversion: When we accept God’s grace and live a Christian life we have a conversion!

- Read page 202-203: How are the Sacraments of Initiation celebrated for adults?

The Church welcomes new adults and older children who want to become Catholic through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA program).

Adults and older children who were not baptized as infants prepare for the Sacraments of Initiation through the Rite of Christian Initiation.

- On page 203: After you have read A Night to Remember, have ever been to the Easter Vigil? The Easter Vigil takes place on Easter Saturday. In this liturgy, we celebrate the Resurrection and welcome new members into the Body of Christ.
