



Coronavirus Precautions

- The Sign of Peace is suspended. During the Our Father parishioners should not hold hands.
- The distribution of the Precious Blood is suspended.
 - Catholics are reminded that Christ is sacramentally present, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity, in even the smallest fragment of the Eucharist and it is not necessary to receive both the host and the chalice to receive Christ in the Eucharist.
- When receiving the Body of Christ, it is encouraged that you receive in the hand.
- Holy Water Fonts are to be drained.
 - Continue to make a Sign of the Cross as you enter the Church.
- Parishes are encouraged to provide hand sanitizer near the entrances of their buildings.
- If you feel sick, it is encouraged that you stay home and do not attend Mass.
- Please follow common sense hygiene practices.
