Dear Parishioners,

The Descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and Mary, the mother of Jesus, is often referred to as the Birthday of the Church because the Holy Spirit gave the Apostles and the other disciples the courage to go out and proclaim the Gospel to all peoples. God has a very specific plan for salvation, a plan which continues to unfold in our time by the power of the Holy Spirit. God the Father sent His Son into the world to save the world from sin and death and the Holy Spirit makes Jesus present in every age and every place.

Finally, I ask for your prayerful support for Douglas Adams as he continues in the Deacon Preparation Program. Mr. Adams is one of our lectors and began his deacon preparation in Arkansas before he came to Suffern as Superintendent of the Ramapo Central School District. Douglas Adams is about a year away from ordination as a deacon.

All of this is a strong reminder of how God continues to work in our midst through the sacraments and the work of the Church established by Christ and guided by the Holy Spirit.
