## MISSIONARY APPEAL AUGUST 14-15, 2015

Diocese of Alleppey, India

People living in the area of Diocese of Alleppey, India are very poor; mostly rural fishermen who live from their daily catch. Unemployment is prevalent as there are no alternative resources. Hence, the Diocese struggles hard financially to sustain the pastoral and welfare projects. Moreover, government's negligence to the basic needs increases the misery of the poor; especially with regard to health issues. Waterborne diseases are common in the area due to lack of safe and regular drinking water. As this region receives plenty of rain, from the appeal proceedings Rain Water Harvesting Tanks (a capacity of 1325 gal) will be constructed and given to each of these poor families for sustainable safe potable water.

As the cost of education is rocketing, getting higher education for the children from poor families is only a dream. Diocese of Alleppey helps the youth from poor families who are aspiring for higher education; and thereby, these poor families are freed from the cluster of poverty eventually.
