A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

A blessed Palm Sunday and Holy Week to everyone. I first want to thank Father Innocent for his deeply spiritual and inspiring talks on Tuesday evenings throughout this Lent. We are truly blessed to have Father Innocent with us. We are also blessed to have the Sisters of Life providing the music for us today at the 11:30 Mass and to have Father Glenn Sudano with us preaching at all the Masses to introduce our Holy Week Mission.

We come now to the climax of Lent, and turn our attention to the solemn days of Holy Week which begins today. I pray that all of us will come together here to participate in the Solemn Liturgies of the Easter Triduum: The Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday Night, the Solemn Liturgy of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, culminating with the great Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday Night and the Easter Sunday Masses.

To add to the blessings of this week we have our special Holy Week Mission preached by Father Glenn Sudano of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings this week, March 26-28, beginning at 7:30pm each night. Father Sudano is a gifted and renowned preacher and spiritual guide, and I am so grateful that he is able to give us this sacred time.

Father Sudano will preach on God's Mercy Monday night with individual Confessions available. Indeed Confession will be available on Monday (Reconciliation Monday) from 3:00pm to 9:00pm here and at every Parish throughout the Archdiocese. On Tuesday evening the focus will be on healing, when Father Sudano will pray over each person throughout the Church with the Blessed Sacrament in a powerful and moving healing ceremony. Wednesday night will be the closing Mass of the Mission with the homily as the final talk of the Mission.

A further added feature of Holy Week this year for our Parish's 150th Anniversary is the out-door Live Stations of the Cross and Passion Play on Good Friday at 5:00pm, beginning with a Procession up Lafayette Avenue with a 16 foot Cross. Please join in the Procession to lift high the Cross to make this a powerful and beautiful witness to our Faith on the day our Lord Jesus suffered and died for us.

May we make this Holy Week a sacred time dedicated to God who wants to touch each one of us

in a very special way if we just give Him the time. I pray that this Holy Week and Easter be a profound moment of Grace for all of you, and that the Joy of Easter be yours in abundance. May God bless us all.
